### What is Civil Services Exam(IAS)?

- After passing the Graduation or during the Graduation many students think about to appear or start the preparation of IAS exam, but due to limited amount of knowledge they did not start their preparation.
- Every year Civil services Exam or IAS Exam conducted by UPSC ( Union Public Service Commission of India). Through this CSE Exam UPSC fulfill the post of All India Services (IAS,IPS, and IFoS), Group-A and Group-B Services

- Every year more than 7 lakh students applied from different parts of country for IAS prelims Exam, but half IAS aspirants gave the prelims Exam and rest of the candidate skip the prelims exam due to many reasons
- The short form of Indian Administrative Service is IAS. It is one of the prestigious services in India and among the 24 Group-A and Group B services for the which the UPSC conduct Civil Services Examination (CSE) every year for selecting the candidates.
- An officer selected into the Indian Administrative Service appointed as the collector, commissioner, head of public sector units, chief secretary, cabinet secretary etc. Not only the experience and challenges but also the scope of making positive changes in the Indian Society makes IAS a unique career choice.

### What is the basic Educational qualification for CSE exam ?

1. The candidate must hold a **PASS BACHELOR'S** degree from any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University, under Section-3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification.
2. Candidates who have appeared or intend to appear for the final examination and are awaiting results are also eligible to apply for the Preliminary Examination.

### Age Limit

- Age of a general candidate should be **minimum 21 years** and **maximum of 32 years**.
- There is a **relaxation in age** for a candidates who belongs to:-
- SC /ST: Up to 5 years
- OBC : Up to 3 years
- State of Jammu & Kashmir (Domiciled during the period from the 1st January 1980 to 31st December 1989: Up to 5 years.
- Defence Services personnel: Up to 5 years

- Ex-servicemen including Commissioned officers and ECOs/SSCOs who have rendered at least 5 years Military Service as on and have been released: Up to 5 years
- Blind, deaf-mute and Orthopaedically handicapped persons: Up to 10 years

### **How many times candidate appear in the CSE examination**

- General Candidates: 6 attempts
- SC and ST Candidates :- No Restriction
- OBC Candidates :- 9 Attempts
- Physically handicapped- 9 attempts for general and OBC

### **Pattern of Examination**

- CSE(IAS) Exam divide into three stages

**Stage -1 Prelims Examination (MCQ Type)**

**Stage- 2 Mains Examination (Descriptive Type )**

**Stage- 3 Interview**

**Paper-1 General Studies (Total Questions:-100, Total Marks:200)**

**Paper-2 CSAT (Total Questions:- 80, Total Marks:200)**

**Note:- Paper-2 is Qualifying in Nature.**

Paper – I Essay – Max: Marks:-250

Paper – II (Indian Heritage and Culture, History and Geography of the World and Society) Max: Marks:-250

Paper – III (Governance, Constitution, Polity, Social Justice and International relations) Max: Marks:-250

Paper – IV (Technology, Economic Development, Bio-diversity, Environment, Security and Disaster Management) Max: Marks:-250

Paper – V (Ethics, Integrity and Aptitude) Max: Marks:-250

Paper – VI Optional Subject – Paper 1 Max: Marks:-250

Paper – VII Optional Subject – Paper II Max: Marks:-250

Language Paper Max: Marks:-300

English Paper Max: Marks:-300
